The Founder's Day Pledge

Suggested Instructions: *As part of the decorations, three yellow candles may be placed in the center of the head banquet table. The member selected to officiate over the Founder's Day Pledge begins the Ritual by lighting these candles, saying BETA as she lights the first candle, SIGMA as she lights the second, and PHI as she lights the third. The officiant then says, PLEASE RISE AND REPEAT AFTER ME OUR FOUNDER'S DAY PLEDGE. To allow audience participation as she reads, she pauses where the dots indicate.*
